What classifications are required to perform plumbing work?

Contractors holding Mechanical Work who perform plumbing jobs must also have a Master Plumber license with the State Plumbing Board of Louisiana, or use a subcontractor or employee that holds the Master Plumber license to oversee the plumbing job.

A contractor may bid and perform plumbing jobs of any size if the contractor holds the classification(s) of:

1. Mechanical Work, or

2. Plumbing

Master Plumbers holding a license with the State Plumbing Board of Louisiana must hold one of the classifications above with the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors to bid or perform plumbing jobs over \$10,000.

Since the State Plumbing Board of Louisiana gives a trade examination approved by this Board, Master Plumbers are exempt from taking a trade examination to obtain the Plumbing classification with this Board.
