Pay Attention Before Hiring A Contractor

The purpose of the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors (LSLBC) is the protection of the health, safety, and general welfare of citizens dealing and engaged with contractors in order to defend against incompetent, unlawful, and fraudulent acts of companies performing construction in the State of Louisiana. LSLBC monitors construction projects to ensure the compliance of the regulations and licensing laws of this State. It is the responsibility of contractors to comply with these laws as well as citizens and construction project owners. The cheapest price and promises that sound too good to be true should be verified before spending your money. Cutting corners and violating the Louisiana contractor licensing laws can be an expensive and regretful experience. Before hiring a contractor, we encourage you to make sure that they are properly licensed; get at least three other bids, and check local references of the contractor experience. Louisiana has many outstanding contractors that do excellent work. Pay attention and be careful in the contractor selection process.
