

LSLBC kicks off the new year with two new Louisiana testing locations in Chalmette and Lafayette!

In an effort to make the examinations process more accessible to contractors applying for a new license or for a new classification, the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors (LSLBC) has partnered with two additional testing sites: Nunez Community College in Chalmette and South Louisiana Community College in Lafayette. LSLBC will begin testing at each of these centers within the next month. These testing sites will complement the sites already in place, which include Bossier Parish Community College in Bossier City, Delta Technical Community College in Monroe, Louisiana State University at Alexandria, Sowela Technical Community College in Lake Charles, Fletcher Technical Community College in Schriever, Delgado Community College in New Orleans, and the Board's testing center at its Baton Rouge offices.

The addition of these two new testing centers provides contractor license applicants a testing center within 100 miles of any location in Louisiana.

LSLBC administered over 4,000 exams to contractors' representatives in 2016 as part of its screening process for license applications and for the granting of additional classifications. These exams included both the Business and Law examination (basics of running a contracting business and the Louisiana Contractors Licensing Law) and trade examinations for the fields of work for the classifications being sought.
