Classification Description

Refers to the installation, maintenance and repair of ceramic tile, resilient tile, terrazzo systems, and marble flooring and slabs.



Introduction

<u>Tile, Terrazzo, and Marble</u> is a *closed book* examination with 50 multiple-choice questions and a minimum passing score of 70. You will have *two hours* to complete this examination.
