Ms. Morgan gave a summary of the allegations and read the settlement offer submitted by RONALD EWING. Mr. Hamilton made a motion to accept the settlement offer as presented, which included a no contest plea. Mr. Morse seconded. The motion passed.

3. **JASON MCKNIGHT D/B/A AMAZING SIDING & ROOFING**, Beaumont, Texas – La. R.S. 37:2175.3(A)(1)
