



CONSTRUCTION AND CLEANING, LLC. Mr. Morse made a motion to suspend the license or registration of the aforementioned companies and individuals back to the date of last insurance coverage, to issue a cease and desist order, to assess a \$500 fine plus \$500 in administrative cost, to allow the company's license/registration to be reissued upon proof of insurance coverage and to allow staff to reinstate the license or registration if proof of no lapse is provided. Mr. Wyman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**D. COMPLIANCE HEARINGS:**

1. **MIKE TYSON D/B/A TYSON'S DO ALL SERVICE**, Covington, Louisiana – La. R.S. 37:2175.3(A)(1) and 2175.3(A)(8)

Ms. Morgan gave a summary of the allegations. No one was present on behalf of MIKE TYSON D/B/A TYSON'S DO ALL SERVICE. Investigator James Franklin was called to the stand and was sworn in. Mr. Franklin reviewed the exhibit packet and provided testimony to the board. Mr. Landreneau entered the exhibit packet into evidence and it was admitted. Mr. Wyman made a motion to find MIKE TYSON D/B/A TYSON'S DO ALL SERVICE to be in violation, to assess the maximum fine plus \$1000 in administrative costs and to issue a cease and desist order. Mr. Hamilton seconded. The motion passed.

2. **THE LAZARUS GROUP, LLC**, Gonzales, Louisiana – La. R.S. 37:2175.3(A)(1)

Ms. Morgan gave a summary of the allegations. Deron Brown was present on behalf of THE LAZARUS GROUP, LLC and was sworn in. Mr. Brown entered a no contest plea. Mr. Wyman made a motion to accept the plea. Mr. Morse seconded. The motion passed. Mr. Brown provided a statement to the board. Mr. Wyman made a motion to assess a \$1000 fine plus \$1000 in administrative costs, to allow the fine to be reduced to a \$500 fine and \$500 in administrative costs if the company obtains a proper license/registration within 90 days. Mr. Morse seconded. The motion passed.

3. **JOHN K. PURPERA D/B/A PURPERA CONSTRUCTION**, Morganza, Louisiana – La. R.S. 37:2175.3(A)(1)

Ms. Morgan gave a summary of the allegations and read the settlement offer presented by JOHN K. PURPERA D/B/A PURPERA CONSTRUCTION. Mr. Wyman made a motion to accept the settlement offer as presented, which included a not contest plea, and to issue a cease and desist order. Mr. Morse seconded. The motion passed.
